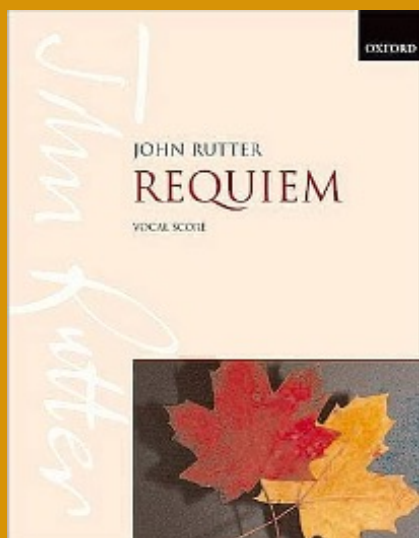


Music at Trinity

The Trinity Choir and chamber orchestra will present this beautiful setting of the requiem on All Saints Sunday. Composed by the popular and beloved choral composer, John Rutter's Requiem is one the most widely performed choral works of the twentieth century. The seven sections of the work (in English and Latin) form an arch-like meditation on the themes of life and death.
